
About us

Portfolio Day & Dinner


In 2026, Investment Officer Belgium will host the **fifth edition of the Portfolio Day & Dinner**—a high-quality knowledge and networking event featuring a day and evening programme.

The day programme targets professionals in advisory roles at major banks, private banks, insurers, and independent wealth managers, with 75-100 expected guests.

We anticipate hosting approx. 25 guests at the (by-invitation-only) dinner (excluding partners).

The event and dinner will take place at AG Campus in the heart of Brussels (easily accessible by both public transport and car). It is AG Insurance's state-of-the-art learning and innovation centre.

Our host for the day will be Hanne Decoutere, VRT anchor. The day will be presented in English.





The daytime program is structured into three key components



- 1. Plenary Sessions
- 2. Investment Square
- 3. Networking Opportunities

1. Opening Session

Addresses major themes, trends, and developments, exploring their potential impact on investment strategies.

Guests include free-thinking experts, well-known columnists from IO, and editorially invited speakers.

2. CIO Insights

Brings together CIOs and senior investment strategists from leading distribution organisations in Belgium to share insights, debate strategies, and reflect on current trends. The participants are key decision–makers with extensive experience in portfolio management and strategic investment decisions.

Investment Square

At Investment Square, attendees connect with leading experts from major investment firms partnering with the event. Experts engage in discussions with small groups of 8 to 10 attendees, sharing valuable knowledge and insights. Each session lasts 20 minutes and aims to establish meaningful connections that partners can follow up on after the event. There are a total of 4 sessions of 25 minutes each (including 5 minutes changing time), reaching approximately 32 –40 contacts in two hours.

By-invitation-only dinner

Investment Officer invites decision–makers from the distribution side of the industry, together with the partners of Portfolio Day & Dinner. Each partner receives two tickets, and additional guests are personally invited by IO. We expect a minimum of 25 invited guests, along with representatives from the partners. This provides a setting in which confidential discussions can take place.

The evening begins around 6 p.m. with an informal reception, where we gather and enjoy a drink (weather permitting, outdoors). This is followed by a seated dinner, which opens with a short keynote of approximately 20 minutes. The dinner consists of two courses, concluding with a standing dessert buffet accompanied by coffee.
